Our Goal

We aim to ensure adolescents, young people and women receive quality, comprehensive sexual reproductive health and rights (SRHR) services, and live healthy lives.

What We Do

YOUTH-FRIENDLY SRH SERVICES

We provide free, on-site STI screening; HIV and pregnancy tests; counseling for couples, GBV prevention and family planning; and modern contraceptives

COMPREHENSIVE SEXUALITY EDUCATION

We equip youth with knowledge and skills to adopt protective sexual behaviors by teaching about sexuality; adolescent development; prevention of STIs, gender-based violence, unwanted pregnancy and unsafe abortion; SRHR; communication; and avoiding risky behavior







What We Do

RURAL OUTREACH CAMPAIGNS

We collaborate with public rural health facilities and health posts to provide SRH services to those who live too far to access the Youth Center

RECREATIONAL ACTIVITIES AND FREE INTERNET CONNECTION

At the Youth Center, we offer free internet services and recreational activities for youth in a safe space

SUPPORT GROUPS FOR TEEN MOTHERS

We offer teen moms a space to support one another and learn small income generating activities and vocational skills such as tailoring and handcrafts

CAPACITY BUILDING IN SRH SERVICES PROVISION

We strengthen public rural health facilities' and health posts' capacity to provide youth-friendly SRH services by training providers on long-term family planning methods and other SRH services

SAFE SPACES FOR ADOLESCENT GIRLS

We offer adolescents girls a space to socialize and access safe, confidential and non-stigmatizing SRHR services; specialized psychosocial support and counseling; pregnancy testing; STI testing and treatment; modern contraceptives; and GBV basic care
